- introduces supervision as a professional development process for health & social service professionals
- provides training and processes for one to one clinical supervision
- provides opportunities for participants to experience the power of supervision through live demonstrations, practice activities and work based tasks.

Objectives

By the end of this workshop participants will be able to...

- define supervision, the role of the supervisor and the limits and boundaries to the role
- establish supervision relationships
- develop supervision contracts and negotiate goals for individual supervision sessions
- use a range of micro-skills to enhance supervisee reflection and learning
- manage one to one supervision sessions
- use a range of tools and frameworks for effective supervision conversations
- use power and expertise appropriately in the supervision relationship
- explore models of supervision and their relevance to supervision practice
- discuss ethical boundaries and issues in the supervision process
